## **Women Need Women**

Do you recall any relationships between women in the Bible? A prominent one is the relationship between Elizabeth and Mary. Take a minute and think of some contrasts and comparisons between these two women.

- Big difference in their ages
- Difference in marital status
- Both were miraculously pregnant
- Both had an angel encounter either directly or indirectly
- Both were devout followers of God
- Relatives of each other



I am certain you can find more from Luke 1 and 2.

What did Mary do after the angel announced to her that she would give birth to the Son of God – and that Elizabeth, her relative, was in her sixth month? She hurriedly went to see Elizabeth. Maybe this was the first time that Mary knew about Elizabeth's pregnancy. We don't know for sure, but Mary wanted to be with Elizabeth.

C.S.Lewis wrote, Friendship is born at that moment when one person says to another; "What! You too? I thought that no one but myself..." Mary and Elizabeth formed a bond like that. They immediately connected because both were experiencing unusual pregnancies. I wonder what they talked about. Angel appearances? What their townspeople were saying? The power of God? I am confident, being women of great faith, that they both glorified God. Elizabeth said, "Blessed is she who has believed that what the Lord has said to her will be accomplished!" Mary said, "My soul glorifies the Lord."

What life circumstances has God brought you through? – or maybe He is sustaining you in them right now. We know that God does not waste the lessons he teaches us. God comforts us in all our troubles. Why? So that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves have received from God. (2 Corinthians 1) Are there ladies around you that have been through (or are in) similar circumstances as you? Women need women to encourage, teach, and comfort.

A word of challenge – as we develop friendships and help one another, let's move beyond sharing grievances and sympathizing with each other. Let's point each other to Jesus – encourage, build each other up, share stories of faith and God's goodness, and fix our eyes on Jesus.

One more observation about Mary and Elizabeth. There was no competition between them. God gave them companions – not competitors. There was certainly an opportunity for jealousy here. Elizabeth was favored by God to be the mother of a great man for God – John. But Mary was favored by God to

be the mother of His own Son. Elizabeth was much older and more experienced. How could this young child be honored in such a way? Yet there is no hint of competition here. Elizabeth and Mary both rejoiced in their own callings and the power of God.

Will we rejoice at the power and favor of God in the lives of the women around us? Will we call out and nurture her gifts, even if they are greater or more acclaimed than our own? Will we keep our focus on God and His callings?

As we unselfishly encourage the ladies around us, we will bring Jesus to ladies, families, our church, and our neighborhoods. We are not only walking with the Lord ourselves, but we are also influencing the people around us. May we purposefully share what God has taught us with others with a sense of comradery. Women need women and God provides for this need.
